
## **OUR PROGRAMMES**

## **ACHIEVEMENTS**




Refurbished and commissioned the Agbekotsekpo D/A Basic School library on 31st March, 2022. Located in the Shai Osudoku District of the Greater Accra Region, this library is serving the 328 children in the school. To ensure the efficient use of the library, a Reading and Writing Club named the 'LitChild Club' was also launched on the same day.


Organized a Mentorship and Career Guidance session at Ayeduase R/C JHS. The "Mentor Me" programme held at Ayeduase R/C JHS, Kumasi, on Thursday 4th June, 2022 introduced the students to 21st century career opportunities. The topic of menstrual health was also discussed to mark 'World Menstrual Health Day' observed aanually on 28th May, 2022. A total of 180 students were in attendance.












Donated to the over 400 children living in the New Life Orphanage in Nungua. This outreach on 24th September 2022 was a partnership with Liquid Love Foundation, Upward Motion Foundation and Read to Learn Foundation.

In September 2022, Deloitte announced the launch of its global initiative 'WorldClass' in Ghana, which aims to refurbish and restock eight libraries in rural and deprived basic schools. This partnership will see Deloitte and Spring-UP Global Network renovate and refurbish eight (8) school libraries, making secure and conducive school libraries accessible to over 30,000 children in Ghana. As an add-on incentive and intervention, the partnership will also launch Reading and Writing clubs in the beneficiary primary and Junior High Schools in Ghana.



In partnership with Deloitte, SUGN refurbished and commissioned the Osu Cluster of Schools library for the use of the 3,829 of the school. November 17, 2023

SUGN announced a partnership with Nana Churcher Multimedia to provide mentoring and career guidance to children in November 2022.
